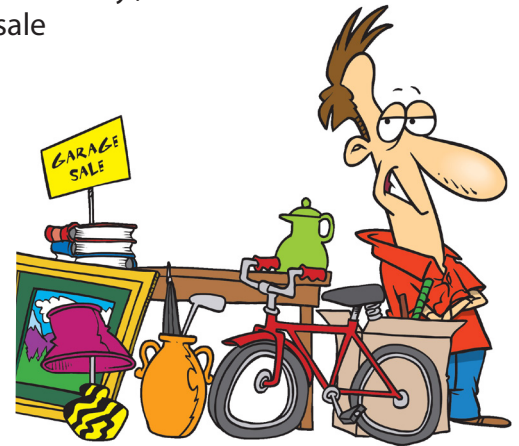
Sellers Tips

Get on the map

- Google "Kettle Valley Garage Sale" and register through the Sellers page
A \$10.00 registration fee will be required before Wednesday, May 2, 2018.

The day before:

- Mark your garage with balloons or streamers
 - This is particularly important if your location is isolated from the main shopping areas.
- Arrange to have plenty of cash for a float.
 - Make a note of the amount. (To compare with at the end of the day.)
 - Have a secure place (pouch or apron) to wear during the sale
- Arrange to have a helper.
 - You will need a break over the five hours of the sale
 - Buyers sometimes arrive in large groups
- Complete all your pricing and marking by this evening.
- Set your alarm for an early start in order to be fresh and ready by 8:00 am.
- Arrange to have snacks and refreshments available for you and your helpers during the day.



The big day

- Above all, relax and enjoy yourself by taking this unique opportunity to meet your neighbours and make new acquaintances.
- Wear something to identify yourself as the seller/cashier. (Name tag, fun hat, etc.)
- Be prepared to bargain.
 - A good strategy is to advise that certain items will be marked half price at 11:00 am
